We are comprised of families, youths, singles and seniors with around 120 attending. We desire to worship Jesus in both Spirit and Truth, currently involving two services on Sunday morning (with a children's program during second service), a youth program on Wednesdays and various groups meeting during the week. Our strengths include an excellent worship team, committed elders, deacons and trustees, and a strong youth ministry. We recognize our need to grow in our relationships with one another, our neighbors, and our city.
